

## **COSTUME DRAMA: A FASHION SHOW**

## **Official Rules**

- 1. Eligibility registration is open to all.
- 2. All prospective designers must complete an online entry form. There is no fee to enter.
- 3. Designers will be assigned to their first choice in Design Category (Light, Paper, Ribbon, Trashion) based on availability. No more than 10 designers will compete in each category.
- 4. Designers may enter in multiple categories, but must individually register for each, and must create a different piece for each category (ie: the same dress/garment may not be entered into multiple categories).
- 5. Garments must be created from category material. Supporting materials for designs must be well concealed, and can include the following: tape, glue, wire, mesh, plastic, elastic, fabric, tulle, thread, ribbon.
- All models for the event will be selected by Costume Drama: A Fashion Show directors and made available to designers. If designer has a model that he/she prefers to work with, please encourage that model to contact Director Sara Fields at <u>costumedramaACT@gmail.com</u>. Exception: designers may be their own models.
- 7. Hair and makeup for models will be provided by professionals.
- 8. **NO** pyrotechnics, open flames or any other dangerous additions. Pieces must be durable for wear in the fashion show and appropriate for a public setting.
- 9. Budget for design is at the discretion of the designer.
- 10. Winners will be determined by audience vote totals, which will be final. Category winners will be determined by popular vote. Each Category Winner will compete for Overall Winner Best in Show. Overall Winner will be determined by a separate popular vote.
- 11. Cash prizes are awarded as follows: Overall Winner Best in Show: \$500; Category Winners: \$250. Overall Winner will win their category, but will only receive a cash prize for Overall.
