# TANGLEWOOD SUMMER CAMP CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

#### **Dear Students and Parents,**

Asheville Community Theatre, a North Carolina non-profit corporation, provides entertainment, enrichment, and education through the practice and celebration of the theatre arts. The Tanglewood Camp is a vibrant, important, and growing part of the educational mission of this organization. We make every measure to preserve a fun and safe atmosphere at camp and we have established ground rules of participation. We expect students to understand and abide by these rules during their time at Tanglewood. Please read the following "Conditions of Participation" carefully and review them with your student. They will also be reviewed with your student by camp staff on the first day of camp. Enrollment constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

### Students taking classes through Asheville Community Theatre/Tanglewood Youth Theatre shall:

- BE SUPERVISED BY PARENTS BEFORE AND AFTER CLASS. Our regularly scheduled program time is 9:00 am 12:30 pm. Parents/guardians agree to drop off students no earlier than 8:45 am, and pick up students immediately after the program ends each day. Picking up after 12:40 pm will result in a late pick-up fee of \$10 for every 10 minutes or portion thereof. Payment will be expected at time of late pickup. This policy must be enforced to allow the camp staff to complete their responsibilities or attend camp meetings.
- REMAIN WITHIN ACT-DESIGNATED AREAS. All Tanglewood students shall stay in class areas until
  picked up by parents or guardians.
- COMPLETE AND SIGN STUDENT INFORMATION & LIABILITY WAIVER FORM (enclosed). This completed and signed form is required before students begin classes. Students are expected to inform staff or instructor of changes to important information and to maintain accident and health insurance for their protection.
- MAINTAIN EXPECTED STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR.
  - Tanglewood students are ambassadors of the theatre and the community. Abuse of tobacco, alcohol, or other illegal drugs or substances are strictly prohibited while participating in Tanglewood programs, both on and off the theatre grounds. Physical, verbal, or sexual abuse of other students or instructors is prohibited.
  - Please do not share food during lunch or snack.
  - o Counselors have been carefully selected and their instructions are to be respected at all times.
  - Stealing, profanity of any sort, possession of weapons of any kind or the abuse of camp facilities will not be tolerated.

#### A NOTE ABOUT DISCIPLINE:

Camp staff will provide boundaries to ensure that everyone has a great summer. We want your student to have fun and explore all the exciting activities here at camp. If the rules are broken, it means that someone else is not having fun. So, to make sure that everyone has fun, we will ensure the rules in the following order:

- 1. Counselors will give the student a verbal warning, and try to offer the student a way to make a peaceful solution.
- 2. Counselors will remove the student from participating in the current activity, in an effort to allow a cool-down and think-through time.
- 3. If the situation still exists, it will be documented and the student will be directed to the office of the camp director. Parents will be notified. This is considered the "first strike." If a student receives a third strike, he or she will not be allowed to attend camp. There will be no refund on tuition.
